

**NurseOne's Policy for CPR Participants**

- Class begins at the scheduled time. Please make every effort to arrive a few minutes before the scheduled class time. You must be on time because the class must start promptly. There is a lot of material to cover in the allotted time. If you are considerably late, you will not be allowed to join the class.
- Dress is casual. Wear comfortable clothing. Skill practice sessions require that you bend your knees, assume kneeling position, breath into manikins etc. Your dressing must accommodate skills practice.
- Do not wear lipstick or heavy make-up, as this will cause damages to the manikins. Jewelry such as large rings and long necklaces may interfere with your practice on manikins.
- If you have any medical condition that might require modifications and adjustments to the skill demonstrations sessions, please notify the training scheduler or the instructor before class begins.
- If you are pregnant, we ask that you check with your doctor prior to class to ensure your safety.
- If you have an acute condition that would increase your risk or other participant's risk of exposure to infections, e.g., acute respiratory infection, or any open wound or sores on your hands, head, face, lips, or inside of your mouth, you may reschedule your training to another date.
- Certification cards are awarded upon successful completion of the class. You must attend the entire class in order to receive the certification card. We do not make exceptions for appointments, work schedules, excessive tardiness or early leaving.
- If you find you are unable to attend the class you have registered for, please cancel with your training scheduler at least 1 week in advance to avoid incurring processing fee.
- No refunds for No Call - No Show.
