CERTIFIED/GERIATRIC NURSING ASSISTANT TRAINING PROGRAM

PROGRAM OBJECTIVE

The program prepares individuals seeking entry-level skills to begin a career in nursing as nursing assistants.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Certified/Geriatric Nursing Assistant Training program consist of 120 hours of instruction presented in two parts:

- I. Classroom/Theory – 72 hours of instruction in the theory and lab skills needed to develop nursing assistant skills, and
- II. Clinical Orientation – 48 hours of clinical training in a local nursing facility, which enables the student to observe, develop, and utilize the skills learned in the classroom.

Upon successful completion of the training, the student becomes eligible for:

- ❑ *Registration with the Maryland Board of Nursing as a Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA).
- ❑ **Sitting for the National Nurses Aide Assessment Program (NNAAP) Examination (for students interested in nursing home employment as geriatric nursing assistants, GNA).

ENTRANCE/ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Classroom space is limited and is on first-come, first-served basis for those applicants meeting these requirements:

- All applicants must be at least 18 years of age
- All applicants must complete and submit application form with the required application fee of \$25.
- All applicants must schedule an interview and successfully pass the entrance examination. Please call NurseOne, Inc. for admission testing hours.

REQUIREMENTS AFTER ACCEPTANCE BUT PRIOR TO ATTENDING

- Evidence of a negative tuberculosis test or chest x-ray taken within 6 months prior to beginning training (indicating tuberculosis clearance), and
- Evidence of a physical examination (with record of immunizations) taken within 6 months prior to beginning of training. Immunization record must include Hepatitis B vaccination or declination information.

PROGRAM COST

- ❑ Application fee \$25
- ❑ Registration \$50 (Applied to tuition fee)
- ❑ Tuition \$925 (includes Registration fee)

Total NurseOne charges **\$950** (Application, Registration and Tuition)
